## MEETING PRESENTATIONS

[Ross Hubbard](#) introduced us to post processing "[Piccure+](#)" which can be a stand-alone or plug-in program. It is image sharpness redefined: adaptive deconvolution. This is a new application capable of correcting optical aberrations and camera shake that cause a lack of sharpness in your images.

It integrates as a plug-in with Photoshop, Elements, Lightroom, DXO, Optics Pro, and PhaseOne CaptureOne, etc. Works on Tiff and Raw files and does a great job of reducing noise. ## **GLOSSARY TERMS**

This month's two Glossary terms: “Pixel Density” (resolution) is measured in Pixels per inch (PPI) or pixels per centimeter (PPCM). The greater the density the larger the number of samples, but less information per sample. Pixel density determines the camera's dynamic range and accuracy or reproduction.

Last month's Glossary terms: “Gapless Pixel (Gapless Micro Lenses)” - A Digital camera sensor, generally a BSI (Backside-illuminated Sensor), that is capable of gathering light from the edge of one pixel to the edge of another, with no loss of light, due to space required for wiring.
