## GLOSSARY TERM

**NOVEMBER – GLOSSARY TERM: Kelvin (K):** is the base unit of temperature in the International System of Units (SI). Digital cameras and photographic software often use color temperature in K in edit and setup menus. The simple guide is that higher color temperature produces an image with enhanced white and blue hues. The reduction in color temperature produces an image more dominated by reddish, "warmer" colors. As photographers when we talk about warm lighting (or color) for a photo, we are referring to colors in the range of red, orange, and yellow. When we talk about cool lighting (or color) we are talking about colors such as cyan and blue.

**OCTOBER – GLOSSARY TERM: GNSS (Global Navigation Satellite System):** GNSS is an alternative to the well-known GPS (Global Positioning System) found in numerous cameras. With location data available in the camera, users can save location info to the metadata of individual images. GNSS is also a satellite navigation system that uses satellites to deliver autonomous geo-spatial positioning to small electronic receivers. It is precise to within a few centimeters to meters using time signals transmitted along line of sight by radio from space.



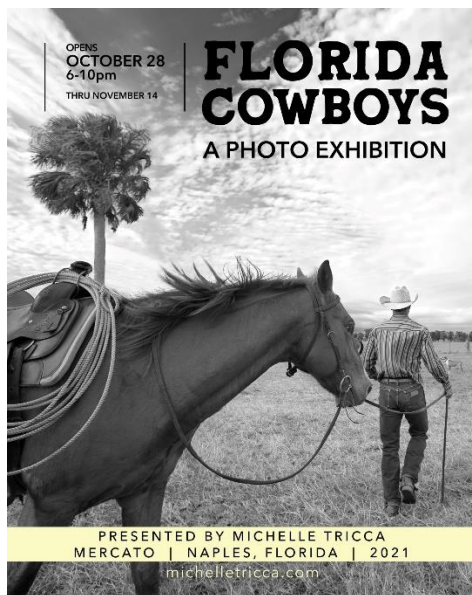
It can allow an electronic receiver, like a GNSS-equipped camera, to calculate local time with high precision. Whereas GPS is limited to satellites within its own system, a GNSS system can access satellites across various systems, including GPS, ensuring higher accuracy and better stability.

**GPS Global Positioning System:** is a network of satellites and receiving devices used to determine the location of something on Earth and found in numerous cameras. GPS does not require the user to transmit any data, and it operates independently of any telephonic or internet reception, though these technologies can enhance the usefulness of the GPS positioning information. The GPS provides critical positioning capabilities to users around the world.

**EXHIBITION: ARTIS-NAPLES** - On Exhibition until December 5, located on the first floor of The Baker Museum, the street photography of Helen Levitt. For more than 70 years, Helen Levitt (1913-2009) used her camera to capture fresh and unstudied views of everyday life on the streets of New York City. The Brooklyn native began taking photographs in the mid-1930s, roaming through the Lower East Side, Spanish Harlem and other urban neighborhoods. Levitt's photographs, first in black and white and later in color, document neighborhood matriarchs planted on their front stoops, pedestrians negotiating New York's busy sidewalks and, perhaps most famously, boisterous children at play. Her work reflects a New York that is both timeless and idiosyncratic, revealing the poignant and mundane aspects of daily existence in the city's residential neighborhoods rather than the slick, glamorous Manhattan of films and fashion magazines.
