GLOSSARY TERM

<u>FEBRUARY - GLOSSARY TERM:</u> Flambient: As the name suggests, a Flambient Photo is a combination of two styles of photography in order to achieve the best possible final image. It is a photography shooting method that mostly used by real estate photographers. It involves combining both flash and ambient light exposures and using editing software. The key benefits of this method is it's quick to edit, meaning less processing time, so lower editing cost.

JANUARY - GLOSSARY TERM: Mosaic balance: Mosaic balance (or crystallographic balance) results from balanced chaos. Think Jackson Pollack paintings. The composition lacks distinct focal points, and the elements share a uniform emphasis. The lack of hierarchy leads to visual noise at first glance. The result isn't a perfectly symmetrical pattern, but a type of balanced chaos in which several different elements combine into a unified whole.
