GLOSSARY TERM

MARCH - GLOSSARY TERM: Flexible Priority (FV) Mode: When Flexible priority mode is selected, you can choose to control any or none of the exposure parameters. In addition to shutter speed and aperture, it gives you the option to control sensitivity (ISO) and exposure compensation. Introduced by Canon in 2018.

FEBRUARY - GLOSSARY TERM: Flambient: As the name suggests, a Flambient Photo is a combination of two styles of photography in order to achieve the best possible final image. It is a photography shooting method that mostly used by real estate photographers. It involves combining both flash and ambient light exposures and using editing software. The key benefits of this method is it's quick to edit, meaning less processing time, so lower editing cost.
