GLOSSARY TERM

JUNE - GLOSSARY TERM: ISO Sub Number: Various camera models from several manufacturers include special ISO settings that are below the base level. When an extended ISO setting is below the base ISO for the camera used, the image is over exposed and then adjusted in-camera to darken the image. This results in slightly reduced dynamic range and a risk of clipping in bright highlights. Noise levels are not impacted by using these lower ISO settings.

MAY - GLOSSARY TERM: Uncompressed RAW: An uncompressed RAW file preserves all of the data in an image without compression. All image data is stored with no impact on quality, giving the freedom to manipulate aspects of the photo like brightness, color, sharpness, and noise reduction with minimal quality loss.

It is recommended when both high image quality and developing speed are required, this format can be developed more quickly by development software than Lossless Compressed RAW. It produces the largest RAW image file size.
