GLOSSARY TERM

<u>MAY - GLOSSARY TERM:</u> <u>Uncompressed RAW:</u> An uncompressed RAW file preserves all of the data in an image without compression. All image data is stored with no impact on quality, giving the freedom to manipulate aspects of the photo like brightness, color, sharpness, and noise reduction with minimal quality loss.

It is recommended when both high image quality and developing speed are required, this format can be developed more quickly by development software than Lossless Compressed RAW. It produces the largest RAW image file size.

<u>APRIL - GLOSSARY TERM:</u> Light Feathering: Is maneuvering a light source's area of coverage so that only the desired area of the subject is lit. This helps you emphasize the area in your photo that you want to highlight and not the entire area of your softbox potential, which makes for a better quality of light.
