GLOSSARY TERMS

<u>MAY – GLOSSARY TERM:</u> Symmetrical Balance: Also known as formal balance, symmetrical balance is the most common way to photograph an image. In symmetrically balanced photos, both sides of the frame have equal weight, and each side may even mirror the opposite side. Sometimes subjects are surrounded with negative space to provide more emphasis and impact.

<u>APRIL – GLOSSARY TERM:</u> Radial Balance: is a form of symmetrical balance where elements within an image radiate outwards from a central point. This way, they create an even pattern, adding depth and visual movement to the picture. It can help bring the viewer's eyes to place the subject in the center. Radial balance is created by using evenly spread orientated lines, shapes, forms, colors, or patterns. These surround the center to create radial symmetry. This draws the viewer's eyes into the middle, creating a central focal point. It can be an effective technique for creating a visually appealing photo.
