Topic – Cell Phone tethering

Using a cell phone as the Internet connection for a computer is much safer relative to using a public Wi-Fi hotspot.

If your smart 5G-capable "Android" or "iPhone" cell phone has a "data plan" or a wireless connection to a "Wi-Fi router", it can be "tethered" to a computer, a tablet, another cell phone or to a router .

When you do so, your smart Android or iPhone cell phone can provide Internet access to the computer, tablet, another cell phone, or to a router.

While tethering is more expensive than using the Internet services that are provided in public places and hotels, it is much more secure so use cell phone tethering whenever travelling.

GLOSSARY TERMS

JUNE – GLOSSARY TERM: Alpha vs. Beta Versions:

Alpha Version: is a version of something that is not complete or ready for release. Alpha versions are typically preliminary versions of software, released to test its usability and interface.

Beta Version: The version of a software product that is used in the final stage of testing before it is commercially released. Testing of a beta version is generally conducted by an independent tester outside of the company developing the product.

<u>MAY – GLOSSARY TERM:</u> Symmetrical Balance: Also known as formal balance, symmetrical balance is the most common way to photograph an image. In symmetrically balanced photos, both sides of the frame have equal weight, and each side may even mirror the opposite side. Sometimes subjects are surrounded with negative space to provide more emphasis and impact.
